

Presentation Standards

- Presentation standards promote the 'Pinner High School Values' by encouraging high expectations for the standards of presentation of students' work. In particular:
 1. Responsibility
 2. Dedication
 3. Respect
- Encourage a consistent learning experience so students know what is expected from them and therefore reduce extraneous cognitive load.
- Ensure that students, staff and parents have a clear understanding of the expectations for students' presentation of work.
- Promote self-esteem, self-discipline, and respect for their own work and resources.
- Enable students to understand that their books are a reflection of their attitudes towards learning.

The Presentation Standards

- **Students to write in black pen.**
- **Students to write and underline the date on the right hand side of the page.**
- **Students to write and underline the title in the centre of the next line down.**
- **Students to cross out any mistakes with a single straight line.**
- **Sheets to be stuck in books or put in appropriate folders/wallets.**
- **Students encouraged to use their neatest handwriting at all times.**
- **Drawings and diagrams to be completed using a pencil and labelled using a pen**
- **Straight lines to be completed using a ruler**
- **To encourage the use of protractors, compasses and scientific drawing templates**
