Uniform

At Pinner High School, uniform is worn to promote a formal, professional impression, and to encourage students to take pride in their appearance and the way this represents our community. Full uniform must be worn at all times, including on the way to and from school.

All items marked with an asterisk (*) can only be purchased through our official suppliers: Angels, 317 Rayners Lane, Middlesex HA5 5EH and Kevin's Schoolwear, 104 Marsh Road, Pinner, Middlesex HA5 5NA.

Students who come to school in the incorrect uniform will be asked to change. Students who repeatedly wear incorrect uniform will receive a sanction. Parents/carers may also be contacted to bring correct items into school, or students may be sent home to change. We expect parents and carers to support our uniform policy at all times.

The school will always be prepared to advise, in confidence, where parents have financial difficulties in respect of purchasing uniform. Please contact Student Services at the school.

BOYS

Compulsory uniform

1. **Plain white shirt** - Long or short sleeves; top button must be fastened
2. * **School Blazer** – Pinner High School blazer (sleeves should not be rolled up)
3. **Plain black trousers** – black trousers: single pleat or flat front (Skinny fit/fashion trousers are not permitted; trousers must not be stretch, denim, cord, cotton chino-style or combat trousers)
4. **Plain black shoes** – no plimsolls, canvas, trainers, boots or steel toe caps. Black leather trainers or look-alike trainers are not permitted. No coloured laces.
5. **Socks** – Plain black socks only.
6. * **School Tie** – to be worn done up to the top of the shirt collar, hanging to the top of the trousers.

Compulsory PE kit

For all P.E. lessons including gym, dance, games, athletics, football, rugby etc.

1. *School short sleeved polo shirt
2. *School long-sleeved reversible top
3. *School shorts
4. *School sports socks for winter outdoor sport
5. Short white socks for indoor lessons
6. Appropriate footwear – football boots, outdoor trainers, non-marking sole trainers for indoor activities
7. Appropriate safety equipment – shinpads for contact sports, mouth guards for hockey and rugby

Please note that students will be required to wear their PE kit during all lessons even if unable to participate due to an injury or parental note. In such circumstances, students will

be given an active role in the lesson, such as officiating or coaching, so they are still able to benefit from the learning. If students do not bring in their own kit, one will be provided for them.

Other requirements

- Grey, navy blue or black topcoat/jacket - open to bottom (not to be worn inside)

- No signs or slogans except brand names

- No badges apart from school badges
- Woollen hat if required in winter only
- Hoodies are not permitted in school
- The only permitted jewellery is a single pair of small stud ear-rings and a wrist watch
- Tattoos must be covered by school uniform
- Hair must be of a natural colour, be clear of the face, and not cut or styled in an extreme way

GIRLS

Compulsory uniform

1. **Plain white blouse** - Long or short sleeves with a reverse collar
2. * **School Blazer** – Pinner High School blazer (sleeves should not be rolled up)
3. **Plain black skirt** – Black skirts that must sit on or below the knee. Skirts must not be rolled up. Skinny fit skirts are not permitted.
4. **Plain black trousers** – black trousers with a single front pleat (Skinny fit/fashion trousers are not permitted; trousers must not be stretch, denim, cord, cotton chino-style or combat trousers)
5. **Plain black shoes** – no plimsolls, canvas, trainers, boots or steel toe caps. Black leather trainers or look-alike trainers are not permitted. No coloured laces.
6. **Tights/socks** – Plain black or natural tights with skirts or black socks with trousers. Black ankle socks are permitted in summer. Coloured, fluffy, and knee high socks are not permitted. Leggings or footless tights are not permitted.

Compulsory PE kit

For all P.E. lessons including gym, dance, games, athletics, football, rugby etc.

1. *School short sleeved polo shirt
2. *School long-sleeved reversible top

3. *School shorts or skirt
4. *School sports socks for winter outdoor sport
5. Short white socks for indoor lessons
6. Appropriate footwear – football boots, outdoor trainers, non-marking sole trainers for indoor activities
7. Appropriate safety equipment – shinpads for contact sports, mouth guards for hockey and rugby

- Tattoos must be covered by school uniform
- Hair must be of a natural colour, be clear of the face, and not cut or styled in an extreme way

All matters of uniform, dress and appearance will be considered in a way that upholds the intention of uniform to promote a positive formal, professional impression, and to encourage students to take pride in their appearance and the way this represents our community.
