

Year 7 Catch Up Statement: 2019-20

1. Number of Students and Catch-Up Funding received

Total students on role in year 7	180
Total number eligible for Catch-Up	39 students in total (some students are in both English and Maths categories) 7 students in Year 7 who did not achieve at least a scaled score of 95 in Maths at the end of Key Stage 2. 17 students in Year 7 who achieved a scaled score of 95-99 in Maths at the end of Key Stage 2. 14 students in Year 7 who did not achieve at least a scaled score of 95 in English at the end of Key Stage 2. 14 students in Year 7 who achieved a scaled score of 95-99 in English at the end of Key Stage 2

2. What is the Catch-Up Grant?

The Year 7 Catch Up Grant is given to schools specifically for Year 7 students who do not meet the expected standard in reading and/or Maths at the end of Key Stage 2.

Students who start high school with a score of 95 or below are at a disadvantage because their target grade at GCSE will still be below Grade 5. Therefore, these students require additional support in order to ensure that they consistently exceed their target grade from the outset. Basic skills development in Year 7 and beyond, supported by targeted interventions, can aid this process.

This relatively small group is supported by different areas of the school, including the English and Maths Departments, SEN Department, EAL Department and Head of Year 7.

3. Definition of Catch-Up Cohort for 2019-20

Pinner High School defines a student as requiring catch up support if they achieve less than 95 in reading and/or Maths. In addition, students who have achieved between 95 and 99 will also be offered catch up support and will be closely monitored throughout the year to ensure they are making at least expected progress.

2019-20 Planned Catch Up Support

CAT4 assessment tests are taken by all students when they start at Pinner High School. Baseline setting is outlined below. Students will be monitored closely during the year to ensure they are making progress, and tested again at the end of Year 7 or the beginning of Year 8.

For English catch up, baselines are set using *Read Write Inc Fresh Start* and Half Term 1 (HT1) reading test scores.

English	<i>Dangerous Games</i> Guided Reading Programme 1x per week during period 7

For Maths catch up, baselines are set using *Catch-Up Numeracy*.

Maths	Small group sessions with Intervention teacher 1x per week
Maths	1-1 targeted support for specific students 1x per week
Maths	Purchase of <i>Times Tables Rockstars</i> programme to use in school and as additional homework support
Maths	Purchase of <i>Puma Maths</i> tests
Maths	Purchase of additional maths resources
Maths	Enrichment activities/resources including Period 7 clubs
