1. Number of Students and Summer School Funding

Total Year 6 students taking part	108

2. What is the Summer School programme?

In June 2021, the government announced one-off funding for secondary schools to deliver a short summer school with a blend of academic and enrichment activities, to support with missed education as a result of the Covid-19 pandemic. The main focus of the provision was students making the transition into year 7 from primary school.

Pinner High School Summer School

The school ran a one week summer school in August 2021 and invited all year 6 students who would be joining in September 2021. The summer school was staffed by Pinner High School teachers, teaching assistants and other support staff, with additional help from a number of 6th formers.

The summer school included the following:

- Support with English, Maths and Science;
- Sports activities;
- Art, Music and Drama activities;
- Well-being activities, including team-building exercises;
- Other enrichment activities including cooking, coding, Spanish and PSICHE.
