1. 16-19 Tuition Funding

Total allocated funding

2. What is the 16-19 Tuition Fund?

The 16-19 tuition fund is ring-fenced funding for schools for the provision of 16 to 19 education, to mitigate the disruption to learning arising from Covid-19.

The funding is to support small group tuition for students aged 16 to 19 in English, Maths and other subjects that have been disrupted. It is for students who:

- have not achieved a grade 4 or 5 in English and/or Maths
- have a grade 4 or above in English and/or Maths, are from an economically disadvantaged background and would need catch-up support.

For 2021/22 small group tuition is defined as a group of up to 5 students, and this may be extended to 7 in exceptional circumstances, e.g. temporary staff absence, lack of suitable space, limited staff availability.
