

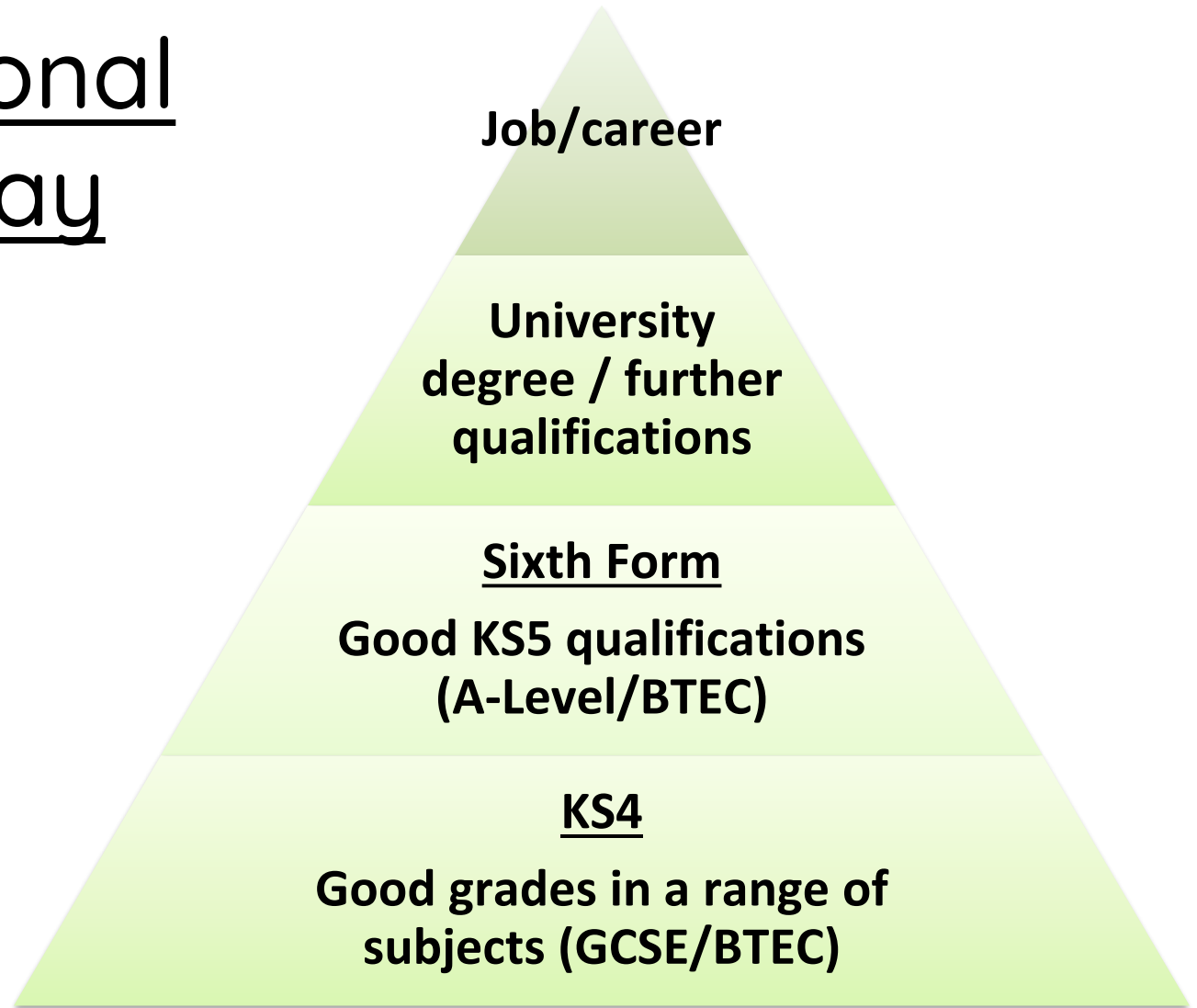

The EBacc Pathway

- The EBacc is not a qualification in itself; it is a group of qualifications in ‘facilitating’ subjects.
- The idea behind the EBacc is about studying a wide range of subjects – allowing students to keep their options open for further study.
- The EBacc is not necessary to be admitted to university.

What happens now?

1. Provisional Forms – students will be asked to suggest their preferences after DLD in order for us to check groupings/staffing.
2. Following further information sessions students will bring home a Final Options Form - this should be completed together with parents and will form the basis of discussion at the 1:1 interviews.
3. All students will have a 1:1 interview with a member of staff to discuss their options. This information will be shared with you. Students will be bring home their options forms for final signatures before submitting at the end of term.
