Instrumental lessons 2022-23 Academic Year

Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome to Pinner High School! I am pleased to bring you information about instrumental tuition for 2022-23.

Lessons Information

Instrumental lessons are taught by a large team of excellent peripatetic teachers from Harrow Music Service. Tuition is usually in small groups of up to 4 students depending on the instrument and level of proficiency. Some instruments can be taught individually, by special arrangement – please specify on the form if you would prefer individual lessons.

We offer tuition in the following instruments:

Brass (trumpet/ trombone)	Cello	Double bass
Drums/Percussion	Guitar	Keyboard/Piano
Violin/Viola	Voice	
Woodwind (flute/clarinet/saxophone)		

The fees for 2022/23 are as follows:

Small Group Instrumental and Vocal Tuition (per instrument) - £285 annual fee

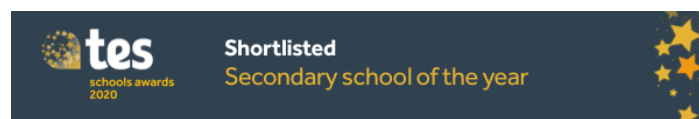
1-1 Instrumental and Vocal Tuition (per instrument) - £530 annual fee

The school will meet the cost of small group lessons for students entitled to Free School Meals.

The school will meet 50% of the cost of small group lessons for students entitled to Pupil Premium support.

Places are limited so if you would like your son/daughter to start instrumental lessons from September 2022, please fill in the Expression of Interest Form on this link <https://forms.gle/vbBhNHqU9iMn2dHs7> by **Friday 6th May 2022**.

Places will be allocated week commencing 9th May, and you will be notified by email. The first instalment will then be due by 20th May via bank transfer. Once payment has been received your child's place will be confirmed.





Fees are due in two instalments as follows:

Instalment 1 - £185 (small group) or £330 (individual) by Friday 20th May 2022.

Payment by bank transfer is preferred. Sort Code 30-93-92, Account No. 51657268. Please use your child's name and instrument as the reference.

Instalment 2 - £100 (small group) or £200 (individual) by Friday 30th September 2022. To be paid via ParentPay.

When your child starts at Pinner High School in September they will receive login details for ParentPay.

As the school is required to commit to a specific number of music teachers for the academic year, payments made to the school for music tuition are non-refundable. Late payment may result in the suspension of lessons.

Students are responsible for making sure they attend lessons which will take place either during lesson time or during break/lunch. Lessons do not take place before or after the school day.
