





# Student Organisation

Students should ensure they pack the following items in their bag each day

- Pencil Case with writing equipment, ruler etc.
- Subject exercise books for that day
- Calculator

Label all uniform and equipment with your child's full name and form

Lockers are available for all students

- Students must use their own padlocks
  - 4 Digit combination locks are recommended

# Supporting your Child

Get to know their timetable

- Place copies on the fridge and take a picture of it on your phone
- Use this to ensure they have the correct equipment/kit for the day

Encourage them to complete homework the day it's set

- Set up SIMS Parent App and Google Classroom on your mobile devices and discuss the homework that has been set.
- After they have completed their homework ask them to explain it to you to check their understanding

Write up notes from lessons to reinforce subject knowledge

Discuss how their day has been

- What they've learnt in lesson and what they've enjoyed
- How many achievement points have they received
- If any issues have been arisen discuss how to prevent this in the future
- Encourage them to reflect on their day

# Use of Electronic Devices

Students may wish to use their devices to and from school

These devices must be switched off and out of sight whilst on school premises

If it is seen or heard, it will be confiscated and returned to the student or to parents at the end of the school week
