

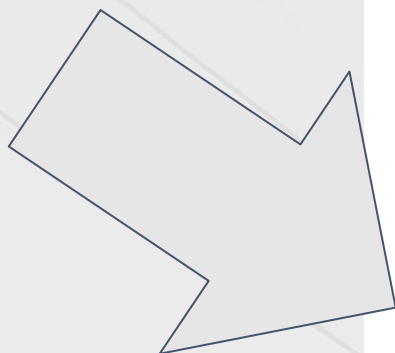

FAQ's

1. *What is Attitude to Learning?*

This refers to the approach a student has to their studies. It includes the Pinner High School Values of 'My School': dedication, perseverance, enthusiasm, resilience, creativity and flexibility. It is assessed on a five-point scale:

Outstanding (O), Good (G), Satisfactory (S), Requires Improvement (RI), Unsatisfactory(U)

2. *What is the Term 1 Grade?*

This refers to the attainment your child has made in each subject in term 1. The categories used to assess this are:

Emerging, Developing, Securing, Exceeding.

3. *How do teachers make these decisions?*

Departments have looked at all of the content, skills and knowledge they want pupils to learn in term 1 and divided them into the four categories. Departments have produced 'I can statements' for each of these categories, they use these when making assessment decisions.

4. *Where can I find the 'I can' statements for all subjects?*

All 'I can' statements are being put on our website. The link for this is below, this will be sent to parents with the reports. An example of one form PE is on the next slide.
