Instrumental lessons 2023-24 Academic Year

Dear Parent / Carer,

Welcome to Pinner High School. I am pleased to bring you information about instrumental tuition for 2023-24.

Instrumental lessons are taught by a large team of excellent peripatetic teachers from Harrow Music Service. Tuition is usually in small groups of up to 4 students depending on the instrument and level of proficiency.

Harrow Music Service offers tuition at Pinner High School in the following instruments:

- Brass (Trumpet, Trombone)
- Guitar (General, Electric)
- Piano
- Percussion (Drums)
- Strings (Cello, Double Bass, Viola, Violin)
- Vocal
- Woodwind (Clarinet, Flute, Saxophone)

Please note that we reserve the right not to offer an instrument if there is insufficient take up.

The fees for 2023/24 are as follows:

Small Group Instrumental and Vocal Tuition (per instrument) - £310 annual fee

The school will meet the cost of small group lessons for students entitled to Free School Meals.

The school will meet 50% of the cost of small group lessons for students entitled to Pupil Premium support.

Places are limited so if you would like your son/daughter to start instrumental lessons from September 2023, please fill in the [Expression of Interest Form](#) by **Friday 5th May 2023**.

Places will be allocated week commencing 8th May, and you will be notified by email. The first instalment will then be due by Friday 19th May via bank transfer. Once payment has been received your child's place will be confirmed.

When your child starts at Pinner High School in September they will receive login details for ParentPay.

As the school is required to commit to a specific number of music teachers for the academic year, payments made to the school for music tuition are non-refundable. Late payment may result in the suspension of lessons.

Student timetables will be on the Music Department noticeboard in school, on Google Classroom and on the school website.

Students are responsible for making sure they attend lessons which will take place either during lesson time or during break/lunch. Lessons do not usually take place before or after the school day.
