1. 16-19 Tuition Funding

2. What is the 16-19 Tuition Fund?

The 16-19 tuition fund is ring-fenced funding for schools for the provision of 16 to 19 education, to mitigate the disruption to learning arising from Covid-19.

The funding is to support small group tuition for students aged 16 to 19 in English, Maths and other subjects that have been disrupted. It is for students who:

- have not achieved a grade 6 in English and/or Maths and require catch up support;
- have a grade 6 or above in English and/or Maths, are from an economically disadvantaged background and would need catch-up support to reach their full potential;
- are from the 27% most economically deprived areas of the country and require catch up support;
- are aged 19-24 with an EHC plan who meet the eligibility criteria above.
