The Harrow Sixth Form Collegiate is a network of nine schools in Harrow that offer post-16 education. The schools in the network are:

- Whitefriars School
- Whitmore High School

All students enrolled at any one of these schools is able to attend a lesson at another school in the collegiate. This ensures students have the opportunity to study a much wider range of subjects. If one school does not offer a particular or unusual subject, the student can be sent to a neighbouring school to study it.

Across the collegiate we offer over 40 subjects including A-levels in: Ancient Greek, Latin, Photography, Philosophy, and Music, and BTECs in: Applied Science, Health and Social Care and Media. Our A-level curriculum offer is almost twice that of all private schools across London.

In addition to collaborating to offer a broad curriculum, the Harrow Sixth Form Collegiate work together to deliver high quality Oxbridge preparation. An annual Oxbridge preparation day in the Summer term runs for the most able students and staff across the collegiate offer mock interviews to prospective students in all disciplines.
